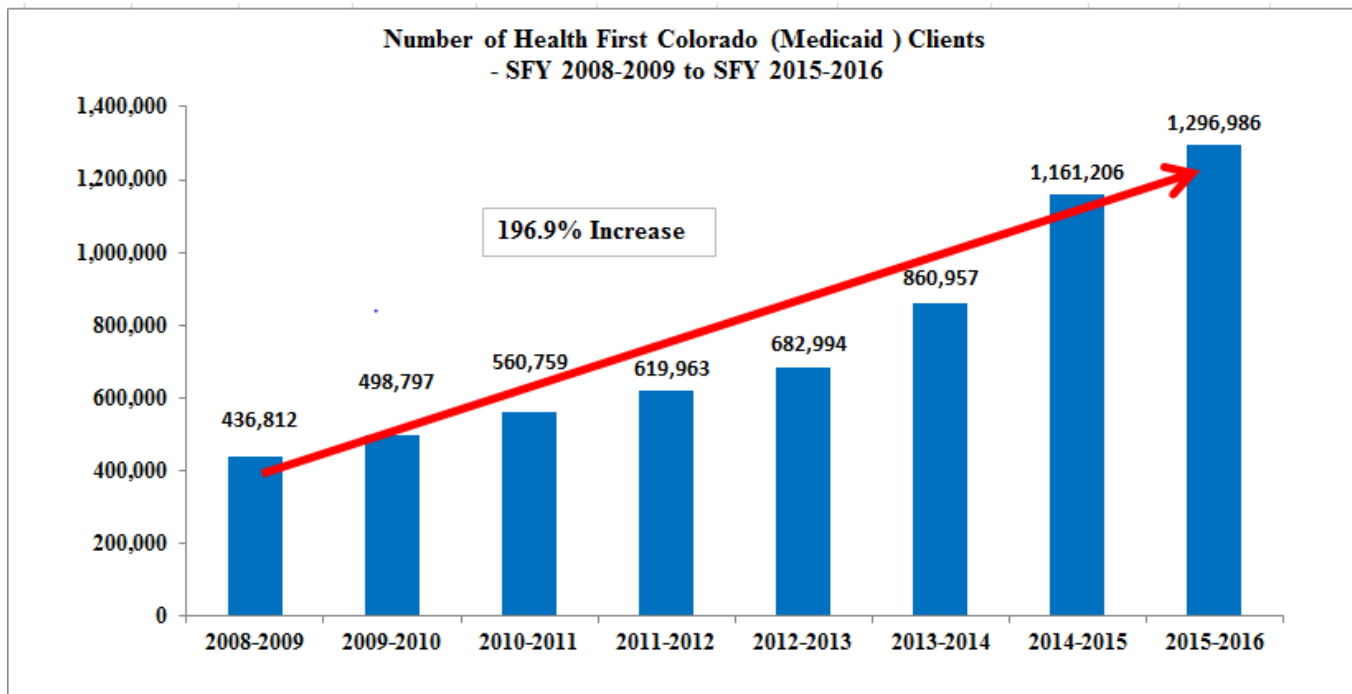


Counties have experienced increases in Health First Colorado caseloads. In recent years, a number of factors have led to caseload increases, such as:

- The economic downturn of 2008 and state population growth
- Medicaid expansion for Adults without Dependent Children (5/2012)
- The Affordable Care Act (10/2013)
- Counties assuming responsibility for cases formerly processed by the eligibility and enrollment Medical Assistance provider vendor.

Colorado counties administered a **196.9% growth** in clients on Medicaid (Health First Colorado) from FY 2008-2009 to FY 2015-2016.
