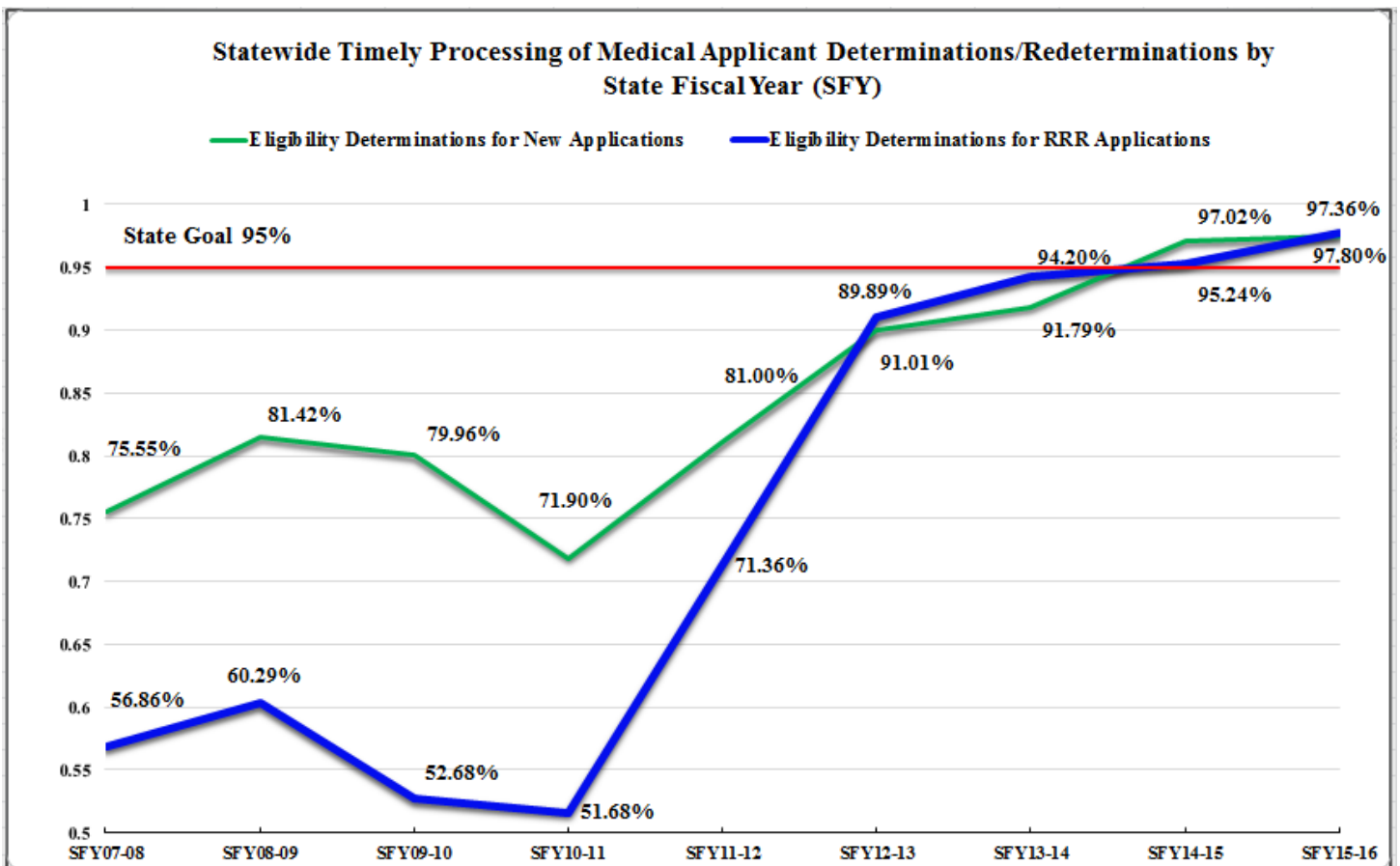


Counties have demonstrated marked improvement in the timely processing of Medicaid applications and redeterminations, as shown in the following graph. Specifically:

- In State Fiscal Year 2007-2008, **75.55%** of new applications were processed timely whereas in the beginning of SFY 2015-2016 timely processing had improved to **97.36%**.
- In State Fiscal Year 2007-2008, **56.86%** of Medicaid redeterminations were processed timely whereas in the beginning of SFY 2015-2016 timely processing had improved to **97.80%**.

These improvements occurred over a span when:

- Medicaid expansion for Adults without Dependent Children (5/2012) and the Affordable Care Act (10/2013) were implemented and assuming a statewide eligibility contract.
- Substantial growth in the number of Medicaid individual enrollments occurred. Colorado counties administered **179.8% growth** in clients on Medicaid from FY 2008-09 to April 30, 2015.
